

1) This year there will be a competition for the best narrative for the 2018-2019 year.

This narrative should be a collaboration of the Historian, Secretary, and Treasurer of the Unit. The Unit narrative should begin with the installation of officers and emailed or sent, and received by the Historian at the address given above no later than April 20, 2019. Entries received after this date will be used in the Department History but not judged. The narrative should:

- Include a heading that is centered and includes: Historian's name, Unit Name, number, and town; address of Historian or Unit
- Be on 8½" X 11" paper
- Left margin should be 1½" to allow for 3-hole punch
- Top, right and bottom margins should be 1"
- Each month should include dates and times of events that took place during that month; number of Auxiliary members that participated; did Junior members participate and if so, how many; number of other Legion Family members who participated; expenses of the event; if the event was a fundraiser - how much money was raised; the number of hours spent by the Unit members; and the dollars donated by the members of the Unit in cash, time or items. The narrative should be informative and interesting to read.
- Narrative should be written in third person using the name of the person/persons when possible. When using pronouns, third person pronouns include: he, she, it; his, her, its; him, her, it; himself, herself, itself; they; them; their; themselves
- All entries will be judged on their content, format, punctuation and spelling
