Things to Consider Adding to Your Time Capsule:

- A photo of your Auxiliary Unit
- Newspaper
- A detailed outline of your best homemade soup recipe
- List of Auxiliary Unit Members
- Poppies
- Auxiliary items, such as jewelry, pins, pens, name tags
- Something representing your town or community
