REMINDER TO OBTAIN PERMISSION FOR BRAND USAGE

Essentially the rules for obtaining permission for brand usage are as follows:

- Internal communications, social posts, or post event related flyers, etc., do not need permission to be granted for use of any of the American Legion Family and Be The One marks.
- Any use of the American Legion Families and Be The One marks that requires a third party to produce a product (basically, merchandise of any kind that you're having a vendor make for you) <u>must</u> get approval through the form located here: <u>https://www.legion.org/emblem/request</u>
 - Please note, this form must be filled out by a member/post/unit the vendor cannot fill it out for you.
- If you are producing merchandise that is strictly American Legion Auxiliary, the ALA can give permission for use of the ALA marks only.
 - ALA *cannot* give permission for the Be The One mark or the American Legion, Sons, Riders, and Baseball marks. You will need to submit through the form link above if your product will include ALA plus any of the other mentioned marks.
 - American Legion *can* approve use of the ALA mark, so if your product has a mix of marks (ALA + others), you can just submit to the link above, no need to go through the ALA also.



WHERE SHOULD THE ALA GO FROM HERE?
